With interstates 35W and 820 next to the hotel, you can easily get out and explore these must-see attractions (** indicates within free shuttle service):

**** Billy Bob's Texas** - Dubbed "The World's Largest Honky Tonk," Billy Bob's has repeatedly been named country music club of the year and has welcomed more than 17 million visitors. **** Fort Worth Stockyards National Historic District** - Located about four miles from the hotel, this historic district is a great place to celebrate the romance and mystique of the American West.
